START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 9/8/08 Meeting:

A quorum not being present, no business was conducted. The following items were discussed and will be brought up at the October meeting:

1. Increase membership – There may be a proposal to increase the membership cap.
2. Constitutional change – The current Executive Committee has met and discussed changing the BGC Constitution and Bylaws, primarily to change the governance from a membership meeting to a Board of Directors.
3. Replacing the metal falling plates and frames was discussed, Sholar Powell will be getting estimates from several companies.
4. Change in skeet fees. The current cost to the club for a round of skeet now exceeds \$2.00, thus there will be discussion of raising the charge/round of skeet to \$2.25.
4. NRA membership. According to the BGC Constitution and Bylaws we require every club member to be a member of the NRA. However, we do not have current NRA membership information for a significant number of members. There is discussion of requiring each member to verify they are current NRA members, by sending in a mailing label from the magazine which has your NRA membership number AND expiration date, by January 31 (like annual dues) or you would be dropped from membership in the club.

September 1897
