DUES, WORKDAY ASSESSMENTS AND NRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT COMING UP

It's that time of year again – the Clubs annual dues and workday assessment notices are going out with the December newsletter. They are due December 31 and must be in the Club mailbox by January 31 or your membership will not be renewed. There are no exceptions to this rule. **In order to send the dues notices, everyone will receive the December newsletter via the US Postal Service Please make sure the Club has your correct mailing address.**

In addition, we will no longer accept your NRA dues payment with your annual Club dues – it is your responsibility to maintain your membership.

We must have the following:

1. A copy of your membership card that indicates your membership number AND the expiration date;
2. A copy of the mailing label from the front of your magazine, which has your membership number and expiration date.

October 1897

Headline: Dick Hollidays Rooster Wins Coveted Prize
