MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which will be mailed out with the December 2010 newsletter, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

On Saturday, May 22, 2010 the Buccaneer Gun Club, Buccaneer hosted what is known in the Cowboy Action world as a Wild Bunch Match. It is a SASS sanctioned match that was named after the movie "Wild Bunch". It follows the safety rules of Cowboy Action but uses the guns of the period around 1916. Instead of single action revolvers, we use 1911 pistols and we also use 1916 vintage lever action rifles as well as pump shotguns.

Since it is new to Buccaneer, we added an open category in order to permit certain non vintage guns and we will continue this category for a while. This match also included regular SASS Cowboy action shooters, since the match scenarios are the same for both.

The match went very well and we all had fun and had a chance to learn the rules that are particular to the Wild Bunch. I have a feeling that we will see more Wild Bunch matches in the future and would hope more of you would join us in this new form of Cowboy Shooting.
