**START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES** for the October 12, 2010 Meeting. BGC Club House.  
BOD Members present: Wayne Aycock, Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Mike English, Sholar Powell, David Rose, John Scott, Ed Weingart;  
Call to Order – Ray Campbell 7:00 PM

The Minutes from the July meeting and the Treasurer's report were approved.

**New Business:**

- There is a discrepancy in the skeet accounts which will amount to a \$4000 deficit by year's end. A notice is to be sent to the membership. If it is not remedied, further steps will have to be taken.
- BGC member Vic Venters has authored a book on fine English shotguns, will offer to BGC members at a discount.
- Replacing a Board member that has resigned was discussed – a change in the Constitution is necessary. The wording for the proposed change is as follows (see related article in newsletter):

*If a Board member resigns or leaves office for any reason during the year, that seat will remain unfilled until the next election. If the seats unexpired term extends past the next election, it will be added to the 4 seats that come open and filled in the same manner by general membership election. The person elected will then serve out the original term of the Board member that left.*

*If more than 4 Board members resign or leave office, no official Club business can then be conducted as the required 2/3 quorum cannot be met. In that case a general membership meeting will automatically be held the next month and all vacant seats filled via general membership election for their unexpired terms.*

- Dick Brame asked that the construction of a 5-stand be placed on the funding priority list and will come back to the Board with a proposal. The Board agreed to look at the proposal.

**Old Business:**

- The Cowboy pavilion will be finished in October, just waiting for it to cool off.

**Other Business:**

- The Cowboy Range has an erosion problem, several Board members offered to help with a solution.
- John Scott will research fixing the mud problem on the entrance road to the club and report back to the club with a proposal.
- The Board decided that every member must sign a Release form for use of the Club property. All Guest's must sign one every time they participate. Release forms will be in the Clubhouse on top of the filing cabinet and in the desk at the skeet field.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 8:26 PM.

## **GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING – NOVEMBER 8**

There will be a General Membership Meeting on Monday, November 8, 7:00 PM at Carolina BBQ. Come early if you would like to eat and socialize. We will be discussing a proposed change to the Constitution and nominating new Board members. Please come out and participate in your Club's activities.

## **PROPOSED CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS CHANGE**

There is an oversight in the current Constitution and Bylaws that has come to light recently. While there is a provision to replace an Officer should one leave office, there is no provision to replace a Board member if one resigns. Thus the following language is proposed for insertion in the Constitution and Bylaws.

*If a Board member resigns or leaves office for any reason during the year, that seat will remain unfilled until the next election. If the seats unexpired term extends past the next election, it will be added to the 4 seats that come open and filled in the same manner by general membership election. The person elected will then serve out the original term of the Board member that left.*

*If more than 4 Board members resign or leave office, no official Club business can then be conducted as the required 2/3 quorum cannot be met. In that case a general membership meeting will automatically be held the next month and all vacant seats filled via general membership election for their unexpired terms.*

This proposal will be brought before the membership at the November General Membership meeting, published in the Nov., Dec., Jan newsletters and voted on by the membership at the January General Membership meeting.

## **MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:**

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which will be mailed out with the December 2010 newsletter, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

## **DUES, WORKDAY ASSESSMENTS AND NRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT COMING UP**

It's that time of year again – the Clubs annual dues and workday assessment notices are going out with the December newsletter. They are due December 31 and must be in the Club mailbox by January 31 or your membership will not be renewed. There are no exceptions to this rule. **In order to send the dues notices, everyone will receive the December newsletter via the US Postal Service Please make sure the Club has your correct mailing address.**

The Buccaneer Gun Club is a 100% NRA membership club – every member is required by bylaw to be a member of the NRA. The best way to insure the we know you are a current member is to send a copy of your magazine mailing label to the club mailbox. That label has both your membership number and your membership expiration date. If we do not have proof

of current NRA membership by January 31 each year, you will be dropped as a member of the Buccaneer Gun Club.

**In addition, we will no longer accept your NRA dues payment with your annual Club dues – it is your responsibility to maintain your membership.**

We must have the following:

1. A copy of your membership card that indicates your membership number AND the expiration date;
2. A copy of the mailing label from the front of your magazine, which has your membership number and expiration date.

## **ATTENTION ALL SKEET & TRAP SHOOTERS:**

It has come to the attention of the Skeet Committee that there is a significant discrepancy between clay targets used - versus rounds recorded in the Log Books & Guest rounds paid. In 2010 alone we are just shy of \$4,000.00 revenue lost on an annualized basis.

We are informing everyone that if the failure to accurately log rounds-shot and failure to properly pay for their guest's rounds continues, drastic measures will have to be taken to stop the losses. Options being considered include installation of Token Boxes, installation of surveillance equipment, changing locks, only have the skeet fields available at certain hours, adopting an elaborate Log-In procedure that may include requiring shooters to record before and after target counter readings. Members would no longer have the freedom to use their club as they have in the past.

As a review - **A ROUND of Skeet or TRAP is 25 TARGETS** thrown. PERIOD! A round is NOT shooting 25 targets that you liked, plus a number of do-overs, plus a number of targets inadvertently thrown by accident.... EVERYONE is responsible to account for and log **ALL** their share of the **SETS of 25 targets** that were thrown during their rounds. "Fractional" Rounds should be logged. Also, Rounds shot by your **Guests** are **\$5.00** and are to be paid for through the **Lock Box** located inside the desk at the Pavilion. Anyone not following these procedures is **STEALING** from the MEMBERSHIP.

This issue must be corrected. Target counters have been installed and our Accounting systems have been modified to track targets used versus targets logged/paid for. The Committee, Officers and other highly involved shooters are being extra vigilant for being aware of who is using the skeet ranges and whether or not they accurately sign out and properly pay for their guests. Again, as a reminder, if a member is purposely not signing out accurately he/she is stealing. If it continues then members will lose freedom of access as discussed above. Anyone discovered stealing will be severely penalized up to loss of membership.
