MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which will be mailed out with the December 2010 newsletter, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

- 1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
- 2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
- 3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

Also, the Silhouette targets on the left side of the berms at 25, 50, 75 and 100 yards are for RIMFIRE CARTRIDGES ONLY. Do not shoot these targets with any centerfire cartridges
