### **MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:**

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which will be mailed out with the December 2010 newsletter, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

## BGC ACTION PISTOL MATCH

**JULY NRA ACTION PISTOL** (Sholar Powell): Ray, Frank and I looked around at 12:00 noon and figured we were it, and we'd just have a fun shoot. About 10 minutes later the crowd rolled in and we ended up with a great match on one of the hotter days of this summer. It ain't getting any cooler by a long run. Had a good crowd of visitors shooting with us, and hope they will return next month. Ended up with 11 shooters, and a good time was had by all.

It has been suggested that the start time for the monthly Action Pistol Matches be changed from 12:00 noon to 9:00am. Many of our members shoot IDPA at Ant Hill, which is scheduled on the 4th Sunday of the month, same as Action Pistol. Sounds like a reasonable suggestion, so for the remainder of this year our NRA AP matches will have registration at 8:30am, start time at 9:00. Always on the 4th Sunday of the month, April through October.

Ray had a good suggestion for getting new-comers to try the game and not get thrown in the deep end of the pool....so next month we'll have a "Novice" class; and here's how it will work. You register as a Novice during sign-up; you'll still shoot 48 rounds per match, but the distances will be limited. For both the Falling Plate and Moving Target Matches, you'll shoot 24 shots at 10 yards, and 24 shots at 15 yards; no requirement to shoot at the 20 and 25 yard distances. So if you want to give Action Pistol a whirl, come out next month with a 9mm or larger centerfire pistol, safe holster to draw from, some extra mags and 100 rounds of ammo.
