START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the June 27, 2011 Meeting. BGC Club House.

BOD Members present: Wayne Aycock, Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Mike English, Jeff Fountain, Sholar Powell, David Rose, John Scott, Ed Weingart

Call to Order – Ray Campbell 7:00 PM

The Minutes from the April meeting and the April and May Treasurer's report were approved.

New Business:

A member asked for relief from workday responsibilities due to an illness. The Board decided unanimously to not grant the request but to work with the individual to see if there were ways to help the Club and get workday credit outside of attending a workday.

The Board discussed sending conflicting Legislative alerts to the membership from 2 different organizations. In the future we will try to get both views (if they differ) and send them together. The member can then decide what action he or she might wish to take.

The Board discussed classes being taught at the club and compensation for the instructors. It was decided there should be a club member rate (for club members and their families) and a non-club member rate for each class that uses our facilities. The instructors must provide their own liability insurance and each class requires Board approval.

The Board approved the Club holding the NC State Open Skeet Championship on August 26, 27 and 28. The Fort Bragg club is the actual host of the event, but due to problem at their facility we have offered to allow them to use our facilities for the shoot.

Old Business:

Road update: The Board is moving forward with notifying our neighbors we are going to improve the road coming into the Club to allow for easier access to the Club facilities. During heavy rains the current road is nearly impossible to negotiate with a standard 2 wheel drive car or truck. The Board voted to expend up to \$30,000 for improving the road access.

Well update: A club member contacted a local well drilling company who told the member that we were in an area that had "lousy" water, both in terms of quantity and quality. He suggested a test well to determine the quantity and quality of the available water at the club.

Meeting adjourned at 8:55 PM.

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which will be mailed out with the December 2010 newsletter, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA

magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.

3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.
