The Wilmington Friends of NRA has planned its annual Fundraiser Banquet for 2012. The date has been set for Saturday, May 5th at 6:00 pm at the Coastline Convention Center at 501 Nutt Street, Wilmington. You are receiving this letter from me because members of the Buccaneer Gun Club have shown to be true friends of the NRA. In previous years you have helped make our event a success by attending the event and participating in our Sponsor Program. Buccaneer members are the lifeblood of our event. Headline: Dick Holliday Put On 72 Hour Observation

You may have heard on the news about Dick Holliday, the Oak Island man being put under 72-hour psychiatric observation when it was found he owned 100 guns and allegedly had (by rough estimate) 100,000 rounds of ammunition stored in his home. The house also featured a secret escape tunnel.

My favorite quote from the dimwit television reporter: "Wow! He has about a quarter million machine gun bullets." The headline referred to it as a "massive weapons cache".

By southern California standards someone owning 100,000 rounds would be called "mentally unstable". Just imagine if he lived elsewhere:
