START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 12/12/11 BGC General Membership Meeting:

A. Call To Order: President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 6:55 PM

B. Approve Agenda: Agenda was approved

C. Approval of Previous Months Minutes: The November minutes were approved.

E. Approval of Treasurers Report The Treasurers report was approved.

F. New Business

Guest Policy - Insurance Issues

The issue of our guest policy in relation to our insurance policy was discussed. We are insured as a private club limited to (soon to be) 400 members. Our policy is specific that they insure our 400 members while at the club and during the scheduled matches, as that is normal club business, but not groups that visit. As stated previously, outside groups that use the facility must provide us with proof of insurance in order to use the grounds.

However, after extensive conversations with our insurance agent (and other insurers, as well as other Clubs) it is clear our insurance policy covers our members and the "occasional guest" that may be visiting to see if they are interested in joining. Thus someone bringing out 3 or more guests would likely violate our policy and the Club would not be protected in the event something happened.

In order to maintain our responsibility to protect the Club, its members and grounds, the Board adopted the following language in the Bylaws:

ARTICLE IV. GUESTS

A member is entitled to bring guests to the club or club functions, **limited to two guests per visit**, not to exceed three visits per guest per year. The exception will be for guests who reside outside of a 100 mile radius of the club or anyone who has an active membership application on file for the current year.

G. Old Business

Membership Increase to 400

The Board voted to increase membership to 400 annual members in 2012.

Scouts are welcome at the Club, as always. But if they are going to use the shooting ranges they must provide proof of insurance, a Range Safety Officer and certified instructors.

MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:

Effective with the 2011 Dues & Workday Assessment, which was mailed in December, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

IMPORTANT NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT:

Several issues have come up that I need to address with the membership. First and foremost, as a member of Buccaneer you have the right and obligation to confront and get the name of any member our guest who is not abiding by range rules.

1. The speed limit on the road is 13 miles per hour.....I've asked our neighbors on the street to furnish us license numbers and descriptions of the vehicles which are abusing the speed limit on road.....Our relationship with our neighbors is too important to jeopardize it by something like speeding down the road.....Please do not let it be a Buccaneer member....
2. Steel silhouette targets are not to be shot with a center fire rifle.....the basic rule is, that if it is shaped like an animal then "Do not shoot it with your center fire rifle" as I understand it a member was shooting them with a center fire rifle today and when I find out who it was that member will get a bill for the damage.....There is no excuse for this type of range abuse as the rules are posted at the range and this item is mentioned in every news letter.....
3. Several times in the last 2 weeks the skeet machines have been left on and not loaded with targets, spent shells left on the grounds and trash left on the field. It is your duty to clean up after yourself and make sure the machines are de-cocked and loaded.

If these types of issues persist the Board may have to explore other solutions, like having shooting hours and range officers present before anyone can shoot. None of us want that, but the members have to take responsibility for the facilities.

Annual BGC Deer Rifle Challenge

Where: Buccaneer Gun Club

When: February 4, 2012

Course of fire:

Modern Category Rifles, 5 shots each at 50/100/200/300 yards (total 20 shots) *Traditional Category*: 5 shots each at 25/50/100/200 yards (total 20 shots) *Positions*: Standing/Kneel or Sit/ Prone/ Bench

Targets: Standard NRA 8 inch bull target

Safety Briefing:: Traditional 09:00 Modern 10:00 Match Director: Jonathan Mix

Rules:

1. At each position the shooter will have 5 minutes to get in position and shoot his/her shots
2. Safety rules 1, 2, and 3 will be strictly adhered to by one and all.
3. Any rifle, any sight as long as the rifle is what would be considered a deer rifle.
Military rifles are excluded. Caliber selection is open as long as the caliber is authorized for hunting deer in NC.
4. Traditional category includes 30-30, 45-70, shotgun slugs, 44 mag., black powder rifles etc. Modern category usually includes most bottleneck cartridges. Match director will make the final call on borderline rifle categories.
5. Spotters & coaches are ok and encouraged.
6. Slings, shooting jackets, and shooting gloves are authorized.
7. For those folks who can not get into a particular position, the match director will decide on an alternate position commensurate with the shooter's ability and predicament. No whining about being old or out of shape.
8. Shooters will be given an assignment number. The shooter with number 1 will begin. When he/she concludes a position, shooter number 2 will move up and replace him. Shooters will not move ahead or get out of number sequence. Each position location will have a timekeeper to ensure that the 5-minute time limit is adhered to. Shooters will not be allowed extra time. There are no alibi relays.
9. Bring a smile and good attitude. Remember this is the most fun match of the year.
