## DELINQUENT SKEET ACCOUNTS

Skeet Account holders are required to maintain a positive balance in their accounts. Accounts are reconciled quarterly and a Excel Spreadsheet Summary is maintained in the Skeet Pavilion Desk for review by all concerned. Members whose names appear in the Newsletter as “Delinquent” are subject to a fine. Said another way: THE NEWSLETTER IS NOT TO BE USED AS A SOURCE FOR LEARNING THAT YOUR SKEET ACCOUNT IS OVERDRAWN.

## MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:

Invoices for Dues & Workday assessments are mailed annually on approximately December 1st. Each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

## APPLESEED SHOOT – JULY 28-29

Buccaneer Gun Club will host an Appleseed Shoot for Club members and their families on July 28 & 29. This is the first event of its kind the Club will host, and for that reason we are limiting enrollment to Club families. The Revolutionary War Veterans Association is providing staffing for the weekend, and they have provided these events nationwide for the past several years. The shooting portion of the weekend will take place in the 50 yard Action Pistol Bay. You will need to bring any rifle and ammo you want to use in this event; from .22LR to whatever centerfire you or your family member is comfortable shooting. The event is an opportunity to learn basic rifle marksmanship skills, as well as background on American history, and how we became a “Nation of Riflemen”. Enrollment will be limited to 15 students, and you will note on the registration link below that wives, daughters, sons and several other categories are offered free enrollment. Only members of BGC are required to pay. This should be an excellent opportunity to provide basic rifle marksmanship training for members of your family at no cost. ## **NRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT**

The Buccaneer Gun Club is a 100% NRA membership club – every member is required by bylaw to be a member of the NRA. The best way to insure the we know you are a current member is to send a copy of your magazine mailing label to the club mailbox. That label has both your membership number and your membership expiration date. If we do not have proof of current NRA membership by January 31 each year, you will be dropped as a member of the Buccaneer Gun Club. In addition, we will no longer accept your NRA dues payment with your annual Club dues – it is your responsibility to maintain your membership.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDER TO MEMBERS:**

1. The speed limit on the road is 13 miles per hour. Our relationship with our neighbors is too important to jeopardize it by something like speeding down the road. Make sure you tell any guests that come to the club about the speed limit.
2. Steel silhouette targets are not to be shot with a center fire rifle. The basic rule is, that if it is shaped like an animal then "Do not shoot it with your center fire rifle." There is no excuse for this type of range abuse as the rules are posted at the range and this item is mentioned in every news letter.....
3. When you leave the skeet fields, make sure the skeet machines are not left on (this poses a serious danger to the machines during thunderstorms), the machines are loaded with targets, spent shells and trash are picked up. It is your duty to clean up after yourself and make sure the machines are de-cocked and loaded.
4. If any of the trash cans are full, take them to the dumpster and dump them out.

**\*\* TAKE YOUR PAPER TARGETS DOWN AFTER YOU USE THEM, DON'T LEAVE THEM UP TO GET WET AND BLOWN ALL OVER THE FIELD.**

**\*\* PICK UP YOUR BRASS AFTER SHOOTING.**

**\*\* PICK UP YOUR SHOTGUN SHELLS WHEN DONE AND RELOAD THE MACHINES.**

**\*\* THE ANIMAL-SHAPED STEEL TARGETS ON THE RANGE ARE FOR PISTOL ONLY. DO NOT SHOOT THESE TARGETS WITH A CENTERFIRE RIFLE. DIRECTIONS FOR CALIBER OF PISTOL TO BE USED ON SPECIFIC TARGETS ARE POSTED ON SIGNS AT THE RANGE.**
