BGC MINUTES

START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 9/19/12 Meeting:

Meeting convened at 7:00 PM at the BGC Clubhouse. Board Members Present: Wayne Aycock, Tom Baldwin, Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Mike English, Jeff Fountain, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell, Ed Weingart.

The May Minutes and Treasurer's report were approved.

G. New Business

Treasurer advised that John Scott memorials so far total \$1,175

Tom Baldwin advised that John Scott Azalea Open skeet match will be April 19-21, 2013. Ray appointed Tom Chairman of the event and Tom is to put together a committee as needed to help him with logistics.

Board agreed in principal that a new structure is needed on the last rifle pistol range (next to the skeet range) which will be used for plinking and matches since the existing plinking range is overcrowded and is not large enough to handle match participants. Once we determine the size required estimates will be obtained to determine cost.

Board voted to allow Appleseed organization to hold a course open to the public on the old cowboy range.

Board discussed the fact that we are \$2,000 in the hole for skeet targets in this fiscal year. Ray to send letter to membership restating Board's commitment to get this in line or members may face higher target costs or we may have to go to a system such as a token system which will be a lot more inconvenient.

Board discussed putting teeth in our requirement that membership badges that should be worn while at the club. Ray to include this in his note to membership.

END OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 9/10/2012 Meeting.

MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety Certification:

Each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with their annual dues payment:

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.

NRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

The Buccaneer Gun Club is a 100% NRA membership club – every member is required by bylaw to be a member of the NRA. The best way to insure the we know you are a current member is to send a copy of your magazine mailing label to the club mailbox. That label has both your membership number and your membership expiration date. If we do not have proof of current NRA membership by January 31 each year, you will be dropped as a member of the Buccaneer Gun Club. In addition, we will no longer accept your NRA dues payment with your annual Club dues – it is your responsibility to maintain your membership.

SEPTEMBER NRA ACTION PISTOL (Sholar Powell): Had a good turn-out for the next to last match of 2012, with some first-time shooters returning to shoot again, as well as a new shooter from the Marine Corps. And we had good participation from our BGC Club members including Ray, Wilt, Lon & Bryan. Mack Smith's son John did a bang-up job of pasting targets for us as his dad and William George from the Wilmington Fire Dept. returned to shoot AP again. Adam Markley from the US Marine SOCOM command at Camp Lejeune was our first time shooter, but he had shot a pistol a time or two in the past. All had a great time in beautiful weather. September 1897

Headline: Mrs. Dick Holliday And The Blind Clerk

Mrs. Dick Holliday goes into a Bass Pro Shop to buy a rod and reel for her Little Dick Holliday's birthday. She doesn't know which one to get, so she just grabs one and goes over to the counter. The clerk was standing behind the counter wearing dark shades. She says to him, "Excuse me, sir. Can you tell me anything about this rod and reel?" He says, "Ma'am, I'm completely blind, but if you'll drop it on the counter, I can tell you everything from the sound it makes." She doesn't believe him but drops it on the counter anyway.....
