START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 3/11/13 Meeting, Board Members Present: Wayne Aycock, Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Mike English, Dave Ernst, Jeff Fountain, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell, .

President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

The February minutes were approved.

New Business

Liability Insurance Issue - The President will create an Insurance Committee to help the club deal with insurance and liability issues.

Bylaws Change – The proposed changes to the Bylaws, which specifically named the various shoots and shooting activities we hold at the Club, were accepted in a unanimous vote.

Multipurpose target shed construction at far eastern field. A motion was made to accept the low bid and expend \$14,250 on the construction of a multi-purpose shed at the barricade range. Motion passed unanimously.

Irrigation at Skeet Field – Motion was made to accept the low bid of \$2025 for putting in an irrigation system around the front of the skeet pavilion and on Field 2. Motion passed unanimously.

H. Old Business

Rifle berm and land clearing at skeet range estimate – Motion was made to accept the low bid of \$2900 for berm, rehab and repair and \$18,900 for clearing the brush in front of the skeet fields so that lead shot can be harvested. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45 PM.
