NOVEMBER ACTION PISTOL MATCH (Sholar Powell, Jr.): We added one additional month of AP matches this year, and will begin shooting again in February 2014. Trying to extend the season, as we are seeing participation increase for this match. For this month, we made some changes in how we run the matches, based on Russ Miller's experience with AP matches in Bedford, VA. We talked about those changes among the shooters after the match, and will continue to refine this for the matches in 2014; all in all, we see positive progression to making the match run a little smoother and faster. Mack Smith, Jr. and the New Hanover Co. Fire Dept. continue to provide new shooters for us; this month in the way of Mack's son John and R.E. Merrill. And we saw revolvers in the match for this first time in many moons, with Charlie White and R.E. running wheel guns. Russ was instrumental in getting the Practical Match up and running in November, and we hope to have the physical facilities to begin shooting the Barricade Match again when we start in February. The Practical Match saw Russ and Ray going prone at the longer distances, including a 50 yarder...note for the future; Club will need a hoist lift to assist with getting our 'seasoned' shooters back to vertical after firing. The Practical turned out to be a lot of fun, and we ran the Defensive Pistol class in this match as well, with the entire match shot from the 10 and 15 yard lines. As always, these matches would not happen without the assistance of the shooters, including Ray, Russ, Mack, and David. Anyone else interested in assisting with this match program, let me know and we'll get you in the rotation. We'll take a break in December & January, back to the firing line in February.
