APRIL APPLESEED SHOOT

BGC hosted an Appleseed shoot the weekend of April 27-28, sponsored and run by the Revolutionary War Veterans Association. These Appleseed Shoots focus on teaching the basic principles of rifle marksmanship, and also include lectures on the American Revolution and the part played by citizen soldiers in that conflict. The shooting sessions took place in our 50 yard Barricade Pistol Bay, and enrollment maxed out at 15 shooters, the majority of them youngsters. BGC has agreed to work with RWVA to schedule additional Appleseed shoots in the future, as availability of Club facilities allows.
