DUES, WORKDAY ASSESSMENTS AND NRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT COMING UP

It's that time of year again – the Clubs annual dues and workday assessment notices are going out in December. They are due December 31 and must be in the Club mailbox by January 31 or your membership will not be renewed. There are no exceptions to this rule. We send the dues notices via the US Postal Service, please make sure the Club has your correct mailing address.

The Buccaneer Gun Club is a 100% NRA membership club – every member is required by bylaw to be a member of the NRA. The best way to insure the we know you are a current member is to send a copy of your magazine mailing label to the club mailbox. That label has both your membership number and your membership expiration date. If we do not have proof of current NRA membership by January 31 each year, you will be dropped as a member of the Buccaneer Gun Club. In addition, we will no longer accept your NRA dues payment with your annual Club dues – it is your responsibility to maintain your membership.

We must have the following:

1. A copy of your membership card that indicates your membership number AND the expiration date;

<u>OR</u>

2. A copy of the mailing label from the front of your magazine, which has your membership number and expiration date.

BGC SKEET ACCOUNTS

BGC policy for members who shoot skeet, trap or 5 stand is for shooters to maintain a positive Deposit Account balance with BGC to cover their shooting activity costs. Initially, a deposit sufficient to pay for three (3) months anticipated shooting is requested and members are expected to maintain at least a positive balance at all times into the future as they shoot. Deposit accounts are reconciled quarterly and the names of overdrawn members are published in the BGC Newsletter, which is intended to be an embarrassment. It is the duty of every shooter to personally monitor and maintain their account balance at all times.

A practice has now developed with a few members to shoot into the "red" during a quarter and then race to make a payment near quarter's end in order to keep their names out of the Newsletter. It also appears that some members use the BGC Newsletter as the source to learn that they are overdrawn. This practice is contrary to BGC policy. Sufficient information is provided in the "Skeet Desk" to allow shooters to monitor their Deposit Account status. Deposit payments should be for future shooting, NOT past shooting.

In fairness to the vast majority of shooters who maintain their accounts properly, and equity within BGC, in the future Deposit Accounts will be monitored on a random basis throughout the quarter and names of those found overdrawn will be published in the next scheduled Newsletter.

Established policy for anyone whose name appears in two successive Newsletters is for the overdrawn amount to be doubled each month thereafter until paid. If the overdraft and penalty are not timely paid, the amount becomes an assessment to the member(s) and membership will be terminated as of the January, 31 Dues/Assessments payment deadline if the assessment is not paid.

Thank you for your attention to this matter.
