START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 3/10/14 Meeting, Board Members Present: Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Jeff DeSantis, Dave Ernst, Jeff Fountain, Tami Hahn, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell, Ed Weingart.

President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 6:55 PM

Old Business:

- February minutes were approved as presented.
- Treasurer's Report Approved as presented in written report.

New Business:

- Purchase of additional lots adjacent to club-The landowner who owns lots just adjacent to the club across from the skeet fields has now put them up for sale. Ray has met with the owner and discussed purchasing 3-5 lots that contain around 580 feet of road frontage on Goose Pond Road. After board discussion, a motion was made by Jeff F. and seconded by Tom M. to authorize the Executive Committee to make an initial offer for the 3 road front lots plus 2 interior ones (lots #23 & #41) with the ability to negotiate. Motion carried unanimously.
- Member Guest policy amendment- A question has been raised by a member about the policy regarding minor children of member's guests as to whether they counted in the "2 guest limit" policy, and it is still under discussion for the next Board meeting.
- New Storage Building construction project- The Club is moving forward with plans to begin ordering and construction of a new 50 x 50 foot steel storage building across from the moving target range near club entrance. Building is to include heavier gauge metal (24 g) as well as a 4/12 pitch roof and other improvements. Construction is expected to begin in approximately 8-10 weeks.
- Firearms Training-Ray asked Tami to consider accepting the role of Training Coordinator for all firearms training that the club permits. This would involve accepting Instructor's Requests to conduct training forms, verifying their credentials and insurance status, presenting course requests to the Board for approval, keeping a master calendar of all training scheduled, making sure HH agreements are signed and retained in a file for all participants, keeping a record of courses taught, and making sure the club had received the required facility fee.
- Jim brought up that there is also a need for someone to act as the "Sponsoring BGC member" to the event and be present to make sure all requirements for signing of HH are met, club policies are followed during the day, and facility is left in good shape after event. Tami discussed some concerns about limiting the number of courses offered to avoid an excess of classes interfering too much with club members regular use of facilities, making sure that the training offered was serving the BGC members wants and needs (not just offered to an outside populace as a money maker for an instructor). She also asked that the board look at each course on an individual basis to determine if an RSO should be present (this is to be arranged for and contracted with by the instructor to avoid liability risks for BGC).
- Tami accepted the position as described above and also requested (and board approval was given) up to \$150.00 for the purchase of a projector screen for the clubhouse.
- Member Manual follow-up- The Board discussed the progress in the distribution of the new Member Manual, as well as asking about verifying members were reading it by use of the quiz at the back of the book. He requested that all members be

reminded to pick up their copies in the clubhouse and asked to have them return quizzes by no later that October 31st. It was agreed that when renewal forms were sent in, those who have not completed the quiz would have their application for membership renewal forms returned as incomplete. Members who have not picked up their copies by June 30th will get them sent out by U.S. Mail.
