START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 12/9/13 BGC Board Meeting:

Board members present: Wayne Aycock, Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Mike English, Dave Ernst, Jeff Fountain, Tami Hahn, Sholar Powell, Tom Mix. 8 club members present.

A. Call To Order: President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

B. Approve Agenda: Agenda was approved

C. Approval of Previous Months Minutes: The November minutes were approved.

D. Treasurer's Report

E. Approval of Treasurers Report The Treasurers report was approved.

F. New Business

Cowboy Fast Draw Travelling Venue. Art Umbricht asked for \$700 funding to construct a travelling shooting gallery so folks can try their hand at Cowboy Fast Draw. The following motion was approved:

Motion: Approve the Cowboy Fast Draw Town Folk Alley request for portable shooting galley as long as certified range safety officers are on site and are the only ones operating the event.

Increase in membership cap. A BGC member raised the possibility of increasing the number of members, no action was taken at this time.

Tami Hahn brought up some discrepancies in our current Bylaws and the Board decided the following after much deliberation:

TO ALL MEMBERS, below are clarifications and some IMPORTANT CHANGES to BGC CLUB POLICIES- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

1. Use of alcohol or drugs while at BGC-

ALCOHOL- The consumption of alcohol on the grounds of BGC IS PROHIBITED, EXCEPT at club-sanctioned events where **PRIOR BOARD APPROVAL** has been given for alcohol consumption. (A member may submit a request via email or by calling one of the 4 executive board members for approval prior to an event). **IF APPROVED**, members and their guests may consume alcohol in any of the **3 social gathering areas** of the club AFTER the approved event. **The 3 areas where alcohol may be consumed include: the covered area of the Skeet Pavilion, the Cowboy Fast Draw Pavilion picnic table area, and the Main Clubhouse.**

In all cases, alcohol consumption is ONLY ALLOWED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE APPROVED EVENT, and ONLY when ALL shooting activities have ceased for the day at the approved range area, and ALL firearms have been safely stored. Under no circumstances are members or their guests to consume alcohol while there is active shooting going on at a given range area, from their vehicles, or at other active range areas. (ie: after an approved event, everyone at the skeet pavilion must be done shooting and all firearms unloaded and stored before ANYONE consumes alcohol).

MEDICATIONS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES-No one is to shoot or handle any firearms at BGC who is under the influence of consciousness-altering medications (such as narcotic pain meds) or other chemical substances which may make the individual unsafe to himself or others.

ANY INFRINGEMENT OF THESE TWO RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP. DUE TO INSURANCE LIABILITY AND SAFETY ISSUES, THIS IS NOT A CASE WHERE "IT IS BETTER TO ASK FORGIVENESS THAN PERMISSION".

2. **CONCEALED CARRY AT BGC**-A note of clarification...**BGC is a "COLD RANGE"**. This means that firearms must be UNLOADED and in SAFE (actions open, magazines removed) position prior to removing them from vehicles, during transportation around the club facilities or between shooting positions, and prior to leaving the firing line position. **DO NOT walk around BGC displaying a loaded firearm.**

Personal concealed carry while on BGC property **is permitted** by those who are currently licensed for concealed carry in NC or another state with NC licensure reciprocity. We ask that those choosing to carry concealed while at BGC **do so in a discreet (concealed!) manner** and require that any CC firearms not being actively trained with shall remain either locked in your vehicles or safely holstered and out of sight to avoid confusion over cold range rules and determining who may or may not be CC permitted.

Open Carry of firearms-Although it is permitted in the state of NC, **in the interest of uniform enforcement of COLD RANGE safety rules, OPEN CARRY of a loaded firearm is NOT allowed on the grounds of BGC** (ie: openly displayed loaded firearms are permitted only on an active firing line).

3. NAMETAGS-

It has been the policy of BGC for some time now that members are required to wear their name tags **AT ALL TIMES** while on BGC property. However, many members are still not following this rule, leading to some recurring issues identifying who is using our facilities.

As a result, for the safety and security of our members and property, we are instituting a **"NO TAG-NO SHOOT"** policy. **Beginning as of the orientation date for new members in February, if you are a member (new or old) and do not have your name tag prominently and clearly displayed on the front of your person, neither you nor your guests will be allowed to use the range.** So please keep your tags in your vehicle or range bags and **PUT THEM ON WHEN YOU ARRIVE** to avoid this situation.

There will be a **new sign at the gate** reminding you of this and the fact that **ALL guests are required to stop by the main clubhouse to sign in with a "Hold Harmless" agreement form.** There you will find **cards** for the guest to fill out stating their name, the sponsoring member's name they are there with, and the date. **The card will then be placed in a plastic ID badge holder and MUST BE WORN prominently and clearly displayed on the front of their person while on the grounds at BGC.** In the event a member has forgotten their ID, they may use one of these temporary ID badges as well. At the end of their visit, guest ID cards should be dropped in the USED GUEST ID box at the front gate for re-use. **Guests and/or members may NOT keep and re-use these temporary guest IDs.** Replacement member IDs can be obtained from the club treasurer at a cost of \$5.00.

MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Dues/NRA/Range Safety

Certification: Effective with the 2012 Dues & Workday Assessment, which was mailed in December, each member is required to provide three items back to the Club with that payment.

1. Check for the correct amount of annual dues and any workday assessment stated on the invoice.
2. Proof of current NRA membership; either a photocopy of your membership card or a mailing label from your NRA magazine showing both your NRA ID number and a non-expired expiration date.
3. A signed Range Safety Certification form.

Failure to include any of these items will result in your payment being mailed back to you for inclusion of the correct info. In the event your payment is close to January 31, and you are unable to get the correct payment/info in the hands of the Club by January 31, your name will be dropped from Club rolls, and your membership terminated.
