MEMBERSHIP MANUAL REQUIRED

The Buccaneer Gun Club is an active shooting club that has grown to 400 annual members. Not too long ago there were about half that many, and most members knew, or were at least acquainted, with each other. The Board has adopted a number of policies to ensure that the Club is run in a safe and orderly manner, but we can no longer rely on word of mouth to make sure all members are aware of the Club's operational policies.

The Board has created a BGC Members Manual to have all relevant membership information, policies, Constitution and Bylaws in one place. They have been printed and are available in the Clubhouse. Please drop by and pick one up and do a couple of things:

1. Make sure you sign for the Manual when you pick it up, so we know who has picked up a copy.
2. There is a brief test you must take and return by mail. ***Please consider this test as a learning exercise. It is intended purpose is to highlight the Buccaneer Gun Clubs policies that have not been adhered to in the recent past.***

These two actions must be completed before you can renew your membership in 2015. The test must be returned by October 31.

The Membership Manuals will be mailed to those who have not picked one up later this summer.

NAME TAGS

For the past several years we have been making the name labels for our name tags with paper labels. Many members' names made with those paper labels have faded to the point they are almost unreadable. Cosby Thomas makes our name tags and he is switching to plastic labels to try and eliminate this problem. There is now a signup sheet in the clubhouse that you can use to request a new label if yours is faded. The new labels will be left for you in the clubhouse.

This does not alter the Club's policy on ordering new name tags if you have lost yours - to get a new name tag you must still send five dollars to the club Treasurer.

Ray Campbell was the guinea pig for a 'new match' we are going to try...just for the single-action Cowboy shooters. The match is shot at 10 and 15 yards for both Falling Plate and The Mover. Time is increased to 10 seconds at 10 yards and 12 seconds at 15 yards on the Plates, and you shoot 3-shot strings only on the Mover. Ray smoked it pretty well in both matches and turned in some nice scores for a guy thumbing a single-action. We'll continue to offer this option for anyone wanting to try the game with a Cowboy single-action revolver at future matches. Several shooters came by to shoot the AP match, then headed to Anthill for the IDPA. It's a good warm-up, so if you're an IDPA shooter, come on out next month. We kept the range open on The Mover after the match, and had several folks take advantage of the opportunity to shoot for practice. IMPORTANT REMINDER TO MEMBERS:

1. The speed limit on the road is 13 miles per hour. Our relationship with our neighbors is too important to jeopardize it by something like speeding down the road. Make sure you tell any guests that come to the club about the speed limit.
2. Steel silhouette targets are not to be shot with a center fire rifle. The basic rule is, that if it is shaped like an animal then "Do not shoot it with your center fire rifle." There is no excuse for this type of range abuse as the rules are posted at the range and this item is mentioned in every news letter.....
3. When you leave the skeet fields, make sure the skeet machines are not left on (this poses a serious danger to the machines during thunderstorms), the machines are loaded with targets, spent shells and trash are picked up. It is your duty to clean up after yourself and make sure the machines are de-cocked and loaded.
4. If any of the trash cans are full, take them to the dumpster and dump them out.
