**START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES** for the 9/14/15 Meeting. Board Members present were: Ray Campbell, Dave Ernst, Jim Caison, Tami Hahn, Jeff Fountain, Charlie White, Wayne Aycock, David Ruehle and Jeffrey DeSantis.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Ray Campbell.

Previous month's minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's report was given by Jim Caison and approved as given. All bills are current.

**Old Business:**

**AP Range-**Improvements have now been completed on the moving target range. Approximately 30 club members have undergone training and received their keys. Members wishing to be qualified can contact Ray or Dave for training.

**Clearing and Berm improvements-**almost complete. Should come out to less than initially quoted.

**Improvements on Steel Plate range-** Ray and Dave are working on a system of baffles to prevent any stray frags from leaving the confines of the range. They got 2 estimates and are requesting approval of \$1500 for materials and work. Motion was made by Tami and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim to approve \$1500 for work. Motion carried unanimously.

**New business:**

**Security System** for new storage building-Ray is in the process of getting several estimates for installing a security system in the new storage building. He will report back to board when ready.

**Monthly shoots-**Dave E. asked that match directors not make last minute changes to match times if possible since it results in folks showing up to range who may not be BGC members and had therefore not gotten the emails of changes.

**New name tags-**Tami stated that she has found a new way to print nametags that will save the club over 75% in total costs. Once the old supplies are used up, there will be new light blue tags for general guests and bright yellow tags for match guests. All tags will be in the drawers up front in clubhouse.

**Loan Payoff-**Jim Caison reviewed our outstanding loans and suggested that we pay off the current balance of the smaller of our two loans which would result in a net savings of \$1865.00 in interest. Motion was made by Jeff DeSantis to approve this payoff and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Charlie White. Motion carried unanimously.

**Cowboy targets-**Charlie White mentioned that some clarification was needed on short and tall steel target placement on some of the Cowboy Ranges and that he is addressing this.

**Corporate documents review committee report-**committee work is progressing very well, meeting with lawyer this week to finalize docs for presentation to club members for approval.

**Accomplishments-**Dave Ernst commended the board for all that has been accomplished in the past two years including: new and improved berms, additional equipment and baffles on the Steel Plate range, moving target range improvements, creation of a new 25 yard multi-purpose range on the old AP range, creation of a comprehensive Members Manual, improved compliance with guest sign-in and use of name tags, repairs and repainting of the skeet houses, new storage building with power and water to site, repairs and improvements on walls at Cowboy ranges, getting the Youth Rifle and Skeet programs back up and running, obtaining an NRA grant to help with range improvements, acquiring county approval and acquisition of new acreage to solidify our holdings and buffer zone for future growth, paying off one of 2 loans on land while maintaining a solid financial status, offering training and safety classes to youth and new shooters, and hosting the Southeastern Silhouette Championships to great reviews. *Job well done folks!*

Meeting adjourned at 7:50 PM.

## MEMBERSHIP NOTICE - Annual Membership Renewal Requirements

Membership renewal packages are mailed to members each year on or about December 1st. Following are the details of the three (3) items that each member will be required to submit.

**1. Check** - Payable to “Buccaneer Gun Club” for the full Invoice amount for *Dues* and *Assessments* (if any).

**2. NRA Membership proof** – Your Name, Membership # and a future Expiration Date (Month & Year) or “Life”, “Endowment” or other permanent status must be shown. Typically this “proof” will be a Label cut from NRA Magazine cover or a Copy of your *NRA Membership Card* (the temporary “Annual Member” card that is sent with your renewal invoice is NOT acceptable). The “Annual” temporary card has a date shown on it in the artwork but that is NOT your expiration date. Alternatively, membership status reports are also available at [nramembershipservices.org](http://nramembershipservices.org)

**Members with NRA “Life” & “Endowment” or other permanent status (previously registered with BGC) need only include a brief note to alert the mail clerk.**

**3. Range Safety Certification Statement of Understanding / Release & Hold-Harmless Agreement** – Cut from page 2 of the *Range Safety Certification/ Release & Hold-Harmless document*. PRINT NAME, SIGN, & DATE. Keep the “Rules” portion for your files.

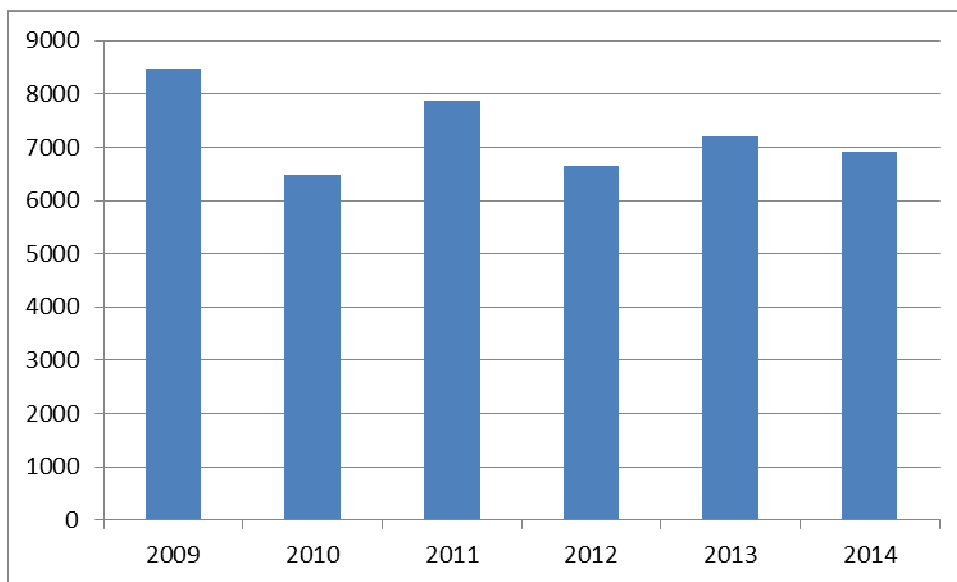
## BUCCANEER GUN CLUB - CLAY TARGET FEE DECREASE

Fees for clays rounds were increased during 2010 including the Members' Fee moving from \$2.50 to \$3.00. The adjustments were necessary to achieve an appropriate amortization rate for the investment in new target throwing equipment.

We have now fully amortized the equipment investment and our cost for purchasing clay targets has remained stable. Accordingly, the Board of Directors has authorized a reduction in the Members' Fee. Clay's rounds shot after June 30, 2015 will revert back to \$2.50.

## CLAY TARGET ROUNDS SHOT AT BGC

Several members have asked how many rounds of clay targets (skeet, trap and 5 stand are all recorded as the same) are thrown each year. It has remained relatively steady for the past 5 years, with a low of 6,470 and a high of 8,470 rounds shot, or about 175,000 to 228,000 targets.
