BGC CLOTHING ORDER (Sholar Powell): Queensboro Shirt Company has now established an E-Store for ordering clothing with an embroidered Buccaneer Gun Club logo. In the past, we have placed an order once a year with the induction of new members. Clothing orders can now be placed by individual BGC members, at any time of the year. You will have the option of picking up your order at Queensboro's facility in Wilmington on Marsteller Street, or having the order shipped directly to you. Here's how it works:

1. You can access the E-Store at the following URL: www.bgc.qbstores.com
2. Click "register", to set up your account, using your personal email address.
3. You then have access to order all items that Queensboro has for sale, with the BGC embroidered logo.
4. If you prefer to pick the items up at Queensboro and save the shipping charge, you can mark the block at the bottom of the "Shipping Address". There is also a "Comments" block for any special instructions relative to pick-up/delivery. Otherwise, you will pay shipping to the address you specify.
5. The E-Store is available year-round, so you are free to order at any time. There is no minimum number of items required; you may order as little or as much as you desire.

Hopefully, this will give added flexibility to members on ordering any BGC clothing they need throughout the year.

February 1897

Headline: "Dick Holliday" comes back from the dead to clean up "The Down Under" Gang

(NOTE: The January Cowboy Action Match was cancelled due to inclement weather.)

The leader of the "Down Under" gang, John Marston, had hired that famous long range rifle shooter "Twigley from Down Under" to assassinate the local sheriff "Dick Holliday". No I didn't say Quigley, I said Twigley. It is said that he was a distant relative of Quigley who was seduced by the "Dark Side". You know sort of like Star Wars. Anyway, the story goes like this....Dick was on patrol on the back forty and Twigley was on a ridge at what must have been around 1500 yards away.
