START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 6/13/16 Meeting. Board Members Present: Jim Caison, Ray Campbell, Jeffrey DeSantis, Dave Ernst, Jeff Fountain, Tami Hahn, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell.

Members at large present: Reggie Fitz-Gerald, Dave Burton, Don Mincher, Zachary Giebel.

President Ray Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

Previous meeting minutes - approved as read.

Treasurer's report - approved as read

New Business:

Range Safety officers credentials-Per our insurance underwriter's policy, all individuals acting as IDPA Safety Officer's (SO's) must be BGC members in order to be covered under our club insurance policy. The Board suggested a new wording to the Bylaws be added as stated below:

Non-Member "Instructor" Participation in Buccaneer Gun Club, Inc. In-house Activities:

The Board of Directors may, upon application from any of the various disciplines, find that a need exists to approve the use of non-member certified "Instructors" (including safety officers, coaches and training counselors) during an approved event of the Corporation. In that non-member "Instructors" activities are expressly excluded from the Corporate liability insurance coverages, non-member "Instructors" shall be required to provide evidence of personal instructor liability insurance coverage issued by an insurer with an A.M. Best rating of B+ or better with minimum limits of \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000. Said insurance policy must be endorsed to name Buccaneer Gun Club, Inc. as an Additional Insured. The following documentation must be provided: (1) a Certificate of Insurance, (2) A copy of the Policy Endorsement that names Buccaneer Gun Club, Inc. as an additional insured, and (3) a Copy of the policy Declarations. Approved by the BOD as read.

IDPA RSO Certification Course-Ray Campbell asked for approval for Anthony Mangum to conduct a new IDPA Safety Officer course at BGC on 10 July 2016 in order to be sure we have enough BGC members who can act as SO's and Stage leaders in our future matches. BOD approved.

Henson request to teach-Tami presented an application from Rick Henson to teach a pistol course on July 9 & 10th. His insurance and instructor certifications on file are current. Course approved unanimously.

Membership Change Proposal-Dave Burton made a proposal to fast track any retired military members applicants for club membership. He wanted to "add a spot" to the membership cap for any who applied. Jim explained we cannot have an "open-ended" number of members as a 501(c)(7) corporation. Ray also said we would need to propose specific bylaws changes and have the entire club membership vote on this in January if it is to be pursued. Dave agreed to think it through further and tabled the issue for now.

New Lawn Mower-Ray and Dave E. discussed the need for a new lawn mower for club maintenance. Ray will pursue models and costs and report back to BOD.

Old Business

Youth Rifle clinic-Don Mincher mentioned the great success of last week's Youth Rifle clinic and offered thanks to Tami Hahn, Jim Smith, George Valsame and Fred Edgecomb for their leadership.

Vintage Skeet Matches-Ray said David Ruehle asked to continue the new Vintage skeet matches on the first Sunday of each month. BOD Approved.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.

BGC Leading the Way in the Future of Our Shooting Sports

Buccaneer Gun Club has always been a big proponent of stepping up and mentoring youth training in the shooting sports. This month that principle was again put into action when we hosted a Youth Firearm Safety & Rifle Marksmanship clinic. Four NRA Instructors, Fred Edgecomb, Tami Hahn, Jim Smith and George Valsame, designed a comprehensive First Shots Rifle Course and donated their time for a full day of training for 10 eager kids on the use of the Marlin 2000L .22 bolt action rifle.

An NRA grant covered the cost of ammo and equipment, and a generously BGC member sponsored the class book fees for the whole group. We had kids ranging from 6 to 16 years old, parents, and even grandparents who spent 7 hours with us in the classroom and on the range. They were taught firearms safety and range commands, rifle structure and function, the fundamentals of marksmanship, gun malfunctions, ammo selection, shooting positions and scoring of targets.

Family members were encouraged to stay and participate in all aspects of the children's day and were given NRA marksmanship books and safety handouts to take home and reinforce with the kids. The kids surprised everyone with their skills and most of the participants were shooting bullseyes at 50 yards by the end of the day. Our littlest marksman was using a booster seat just to line up with his sights, and was hitting 5 hits out of 6 shots on 4" balloons at 50 yards! Now that is the future of our shooting sports in action!
