START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 12/10/18 Board of Directors Meeting. Board members present included Wayne Aycock, Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Dave Ernst, Reggie FitzGerald, Tami Hahn, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell, David Ruehle, George Valsame and Charlie White. There were 8 members present. President Dave Ernst called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM .

Agenda was adopted as presented.

Previous months minutes and Treasurer's report adopted as presented.

New Business:

Moving Trap Shoot Date. The traps shooters wish to hold the monthly trap shoot on the 3rd Saturday and brought that request to the Board.

Motion: Move the monthly Trap match to the 3rd Saturday, starting in January 2019. Fitzgerald/Aycock. Passed unanimously.

Use of Non Member RSO's. The Board formally approved the use of non-member RSO's.

Motion: Be it resolved, Range Safety Officer's (RSO) and Match Directors (MD) at BGC are to be responsible for supervision and enforcement of all safety rules for all shooters and guests. All MD's shall be current BGC members. RSO's may be either current BGC members or non-members so long as they maintain current Safety Officer and/or instructor certification in the discipline they are supervising. All SO's shall serve at the discretion of the MD. Hahn/Valsame Passed unanimously.

Unrelated Business Income. As a 501(c)(7) non-profit membership organization, we are allowed to have up to 15% of our gross revenues come from non-members as Unrelated Business Income (UBI). It has been brought to the Boards attention that we very nearly exceeded the allowable amount in the 2017-2018 fiscal year.

Motion: Use current 2017-2018 Unrelated Business Income (UBI) as a budget for capping non-member 2018-2019 UBI for each shooting discipline. Ruehle/Caison Passed unanimously.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm.

1. Check - Payable to "Buccaneer Gun Club" for the full Invoice amount for *Dues* and *Assessments* (if any).

2. NRA Membership proof – Your Name, Membership # and a future Expiration Date (Month & Year) or "Life", "Endowment" or other permanent status must be shown. Typically this "proof" will be a Label cut from NRA Magazine cover or a Copy of your *NRA Membership Card* (the temporary "Annual Member" card that is sent with your renewal invoice is NOT acceptable). The "Annual" temporary card has a date shown on it in the artwork but that is NOT your expiration date. Alternatively, membership status reports are also available at nramembershipservices.org.
· *Members with NRA "Life" & "Endowment" or other permanent status (previously registered with BGC) need only include a brief note to alert the mail clerk.*

3. Range Safety Certification Statement of Understanding / Release & Hold-Harmless Agreement – Cut from page 2 of the *Range Safety Certification/ Release & Hold-Harmless document*. PRINT NAME, SIGN, & DATE. Keep the "Rules" portion for your files.
