President Dave Ernst called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM

The May Minutes and Treasurers report were approved.

New Business:

NC Forestry Association- requested to use club facilities for around 20 people in October for a skeet event. Ray has given them request forms and explained our insurance requirements to them.

NHRMC hospital Foundation event-David Ruehle reported the hospital foundation has requested we allow them to hold another skeet fundraiser event here this fall (date TBD with Dave Ruehle). Jim asked that Dave clarify all insurance requirements with them up front. Motion was made by Tami Hahn and 2nd by Howard Hoadley to proceed with event pending establishing acceptable date and insurance approval. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Cowboy Range improvements- Howard Hoadley reported he, Lon Layton and Bert Winfield are working on getting together estimates and a plan of repairs needed on the Cowboy ranges (barrier walls) and addition of new berms. They will report back on this at July meeting.

Website overhaul proposal-Tami Hahn & Steve Perry reported on the committee work plans for redesign of BGC website. Committee recommended use of Wilmington Design Company at a cost of \$7500-\$8500 for complete redesign of site and incorporation of e-commerce capabilities to take member payments for renewals and skeet deposits via credit cards online. Jim Caison will need to set up QuickBooks Online and Pay Pal Pro accounts to proceed. Tami will contact Jim Merritt of QuickTrainer, LLC to assist in this process. Motion was made by Tami Hahn and 2nd by Jim Smith to accept WDC proposal and begin work. Yay: TH, DR, JS, HH, SP, GV. Nay: DE, JC, CW. Motion carried with 6/9 in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:35 PM.

Trap Match

We had good weather and a good turnout for our monthly trap shoot. The wind could not make up its mind which direction to blow so some targets were high and some were low but we shot at all of them. There were 25 shooters this month and we threw roughly 1,600 targets.

Singles had 24 shooters. The top shooter in singles was David Barron with a perfect score of 50 out of 50. Nice shooting David. Second place was a 49 shot by Nathan Snyder. Glen Alford finished third with a 46 and three 43's shot by Wayne Averill, Mike Anselmo and Hiram Tucker tied for fourth in singles.

We had 14 shooters compete in handicap. Tim Parvis shot the high score in handicap knocking down 47 from the 20 yard line. Scott McGrady was 2nd with a 44 followed by Bill Mortensen who broke 42. Wayne Averill, Jerry Kinlaw and Terry Lewis all shot 41 to tie for fourth place in handicap.

Our doubles event fielded 11 shooters. David Barron and Nathan Snyder tied for top score in doubles with a pair of 44's. Tim Parvis was one bird back for 2nd with a 43. Jason Harris took 3rd with a 40 and 4th went to Scott McGrady with a 38.

Eight people shot all three events to compete for high over all. The HOA prize goes to David Barron who broke 134 of 150 for an 89.33% HOA average. Honorable mention goes to Nathan Snyder who broke 132 of 150 for 88.0%. Tim Parvis was third with 87.33%.

This month we used the Lewis Class system to determine who won prize money. Shooters were divided into 4 groups/classes and the top two shooters in each group win. Ties split the money. Top score in each group receives 60% of the money for that group and second gets 40%. We had 15 winners this month.
