START OF UNAPPROVED MINUTES for the 2/11/19 Meeting. Board members present included Dick Brame, Jim Caison, Dave Ernst, Reggie FitzGerald, Tami Hahn, Howard Hoadley, Tom Mix, Sholar Powell, David Ruehle, Jim, Smith, George Valsame and Charlie White. There were 3 members present. President Dave Ernst called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

The November and January Minutes and Treasurers report were approved.

NEW BUSINESS

Shotgun Use on Plates Range - Ray Campbell requested we clarify the use of shotguns on the plate range.

MOTION: Allow the use of shotguns with 2 ¾" shells, using lead shot no larger than 7 ½ shot on the plates range. Passed with 1 dissenting vote.

Clay Target Fund Shortage - There been a shortage of over \$900 for the clay target accounts for the last quarter of 2018. The Board will monitor the clay target usage in the first quarter of 2019 and take action if necessary.

Repairing Roofs – The roof on the Club House needs replacement as do the roofs on the north side of the rifle range shed and the chicken shed. The Board received 2 estimates and decided to use the lower estimate.

MOTION: To spend \$15,000 to repair the roofs as requested. Passed unanimously.

Unrelated Business Income (UBI) – The Board learned there would not be a Regional Silhouette shoot or the Port City Open skeet tournament this fiscal year, so there is a low probability of reaching the UBI limit. The Board rescinded the budget imposed previously for the rest of the fiscal year (which ends June 30) and created a UBI Committee to determine how to allot resources under the UBI constraints in the future.

Family Guest Policy – It was brought to the attention of the Board that the current Corporate Resolutions are not clear on the use of the Club by family members; it seems to read that a member can only bring 2 adult members at a time. That was not the intent of the Board, so they passed the following motion:

MOTION – Amend the policy on family use of the facilities to read as follows (new verbiage in italics):

From Page 25, Section C, Part iv

Persons of a Buccaneer Gun Club, Inc. member's immediate family are not limited to the number of visits per year *and are not subject to the 2 adult guests per visit limitation*, however, each family member must still sign in as a guest, complete a Hold Harmless agreement and wear a name tag at all times for each visit to Buccaneer Gun Club, Inc.'s property. The family member's rounds may be recorded on the members account. Until further board action or resolution, immediate family includes someone's spouse, parents and grandparents, children and grandchildren, brothers and sisters, mother in law and father in law, brothers in law and sisters in law, daughters in law and sons in law, adopted, half, step members and fiance's.

Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: To hold a Women On Target class on March 30 and a 2 day Rick Henson Intermediate and Advanced Tactical Pistol Class March 16 and 17. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 8:40 PM.
