Shotgun Shells For Sale - Don't Miss Out On This Sale.

The Buccaneer Gun Club (BGC) is going to sell all of the youth program shotgun shells in our possession. These shells were a grant from the NRA approximately six years ago for our youth skeet shooting program, which has become inactive.

Two of our members, Frank Hassell and Tom Smith, have suggested we sell these shotgun shells and donate 100% of the proceeds to the World Youth Skeet Championship shoot to be held this July in Fayetteville, NC. By donating the funds to this youth shooting event the grant will be satisfied.

Every club member wishing to purchase these shells will have a chance. This will be done by a lottery system.

We have:

38 flats of 12 ga Winchester Super Target loads NOT AA - 1 1/8 oz, #8 shot 1145 fps \$40/flat
5 flats of 20 ga Win and Fed Target loads - 7/8 oz, #8 shot \$40/flat
3 flats 28 ga Winchester AA skeet loads - 3/4 oz, #9 shot \$80/flat HS hulls
3 flats .410 Winchester AA skeet loads - 1/2 oz, #9 shot \$80/flat HS hulls

We will put a box in the skeet pavilion with entry forms. You may enter 1 entry form, if we find more than one entry from someone all of his (or hers) will be removed. Each form will have a space for all 4 gauges, you may select 1, 2, 3 or all 4.

On the day of the drawing, we will draw for the .410 shells first, then do the same for the 28 ga shells; 20 ga shells and finally the 12 ga. The names will go back in the box after each drawing if they selected the larger gauges.

All entries must be in the box by the end of the day on Saturday, May 18. The drawing will be held at noon on Sunday, May 19. You do not have to be present to win but it would sure make it easier if you were. Payment by check made out to the Buccaneer Gun Club.
