Proposed Bylaws Change

It was brought to the attention of the Board that there was a discrepancy in the Bylaws under Article 5 – Board of Directors Meetings. The first paragraph says a simple majority of the board is necessary to make a decision. The second paragraph indicates a 2/3 majority is necessary. After discussion the Board believes the former was the intent when the Bylaws were adopted so the following change is proposed for a vote at the January General Membership meeting (the stricken-through verbiage will be removed)

ARTICLE 5 – BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS

5.1 Board Meetings. The Board of Directors shall meet no less than quarterly at whatever time and place it selects. All Board of Directors meetings are open to the membership. A majority of Directors where a quorum is present is necessary to make a decision except where some other number is required by law or by the Bylaws. Proxy voting is not permitted. Board members may attend meetings in person or by electronic means including via electronic audio and video devices. Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting and with the same force and effect as if taken by a unanimous vote of Directors, if authorized by writing signed individually or collectively by all Directors. Such consent shall be filed with the regular minutes of the Board.

5.2 Director Quorum; Majority Actions. Unless otherwise provided herein, a two thirds (2/3) majority of the Directors in office shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, except to adjourn as hereinafter provided in Section 5.3. Every act or decision done or made by a ~~two thirds (2/3)~~ majority of the Directors present at a meeting duly held at which a quorum is present shall be regarded as the act of the Board of Directors unless a greater number be required by law, or by the Articles of Incorporation, or by these Bylaws.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.

3. Range Safety Certification Statement of Understanding / Release & Hold-Harmless Agreement – Cut from page 2 of the *Range Safety Certification/ Release & Hold-Harmless document*. PRINT NAME, SIGN, & DATE. Keep the "Rules" portion for your files.
